Step 2: Please read the following Scholarship Award Guidelines before submitting the application form

- I. The National Chung Cheng University Graduate Scholarship are based on the school regulations
- II. The source of funding: Graduates grant from National Chung Cheng University.
- III. The purpose of the International Master Program in Global Finance program (hereinafter referred to as the program) scholarship award:
Scholarships are designed to reward outstanding students, both aiming to enhance the willingness of students taking courses, and to improve academic standards by engaging in research. The grant receiver should assist the department on teaching or researching, which indicates the grant is related to the assistance of academic work.
- IV. The basic criteria for applying the scholarships: graduate students who are officially enrolled for the department (including rehabilitation students) with excellent results in grades and with research potential. Graduate students may not be able to apply for this scholarship in any of the following circumstances:
(1) Full-time work inside or outside the school, or having fixed monthly income and more than basic wages. (2) Left school due to graduation, suspension, withdrawal from school, or other reasons.
- V. Scholarship related procedures:

- i. Application: Students who are officially enrolled in the Master's program for the department are required to start applying within two weeks of the beginning of the semester. Please complete the application form for the graduate scholarship when applying.
- ii. Required documents:
 1. **A hardcopy of the application form.**
 2. **A hardcopy of the student ID card.**
 3. **For first year students, please attach the entrance examination scores; for second year students please attach the previous semester's transcript of the course.**
- iii. Scholarship awarded and related regulations: Students have to re-apply for the scholarship each semester with their new results. The rules for each semester are as follows:
 1. The required average score is 85 or above.
 2. For year-one students in the first semester: The professors will pick two students with the best criteria through recommendations and examinations (entrance exam). The first candidate will be awarded NTD\$10,000. (Note: if the first candidate did not show up then the second candidate could fill his spot); the second candidate is awarded NTD\$ 5,000.
 3. For year-one students in the second semester and year-two students: The first and second placed students from the previous semester can apply for this scholarship, first place is awarded NTD\$10,000, second place is awarded NTD\$5,000.
 4. The actual amount of the scholarship will be based on the funding for each semester.
