For students meeting the criteria of major illness under the National Health Insurance (NHI) system (notification of major illness certification), NT\$20,000 will be granted.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> 4. For students who have suffered from parental abuse, abandonment, or forced involvement in improper occupations, resulting in no family support, and have been approved by the government and placed under the care of authorized social welfare institutions or relatives (social welfare institution certificate), NT\$20,000 will be granted.</p> <p>2. In the case of divorce or disappearance (police search for over six months), imprisonment, layoff, or termination of employment (divorce certificate, unemployment certification), NT\$10,000 will be granted.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> 2.
